General Report We held our subcommittee on May 21, 2019, at 7:00 pm. There were 25 members present, including 5 new members. The new members attended orientation. Presently we have 38 facilities on our H&I facilities list. 15 are clearance and 23 are non-clearance. We presently have 8 open clearance facilities, and 7 open, non clearance facilities. As of this report, we have 30 panel leaders going into 18 non-clearance facilities, and 9 clearance.
