- The RD/AD team attended the 10-day World Service Conference in California. If anyone would like a copy of the 71 pages of notes, Ron will gladly forward them to you. He recapped the business portion of the conference – old business being the CAR motion and new business being budgets, project plans, new motions and elections.

- Our AD provided a more in-depth report of the WSC, attempting to give us an understanding of the logistics and workings of a WSC. The AD report focused on the round table discussions. If you would like a copy of the 50 pages of discussion, contact John for a copy.

Some of what you may find noteworthy is.....

- Donations to NAWS from the fellowship cover approximately 8% of the funds necessary to support our world service structure. The Florida Region's donated \$21,909.68 in 2003. For comparative sake, the region of Chile donated \$20 and the Northern California Region donated \$103,339.20.
- 6 new Board members were elected. With the motion to reduce the size of the Board from 24 to 18 carrying, the Board is almost full. There is still disagreement between the World Board and the Human Resource Panel, so alternatives to the existing election process are still being discussed. Nonetheless, overall, there is now more confidence that the election process works.
- The Conference is moving away from the Roberts Rules Parliamentary Procedure and Motions format and toward a discussion based format (CBDMM).
- The conference decided to change the clean time medallions, no longer using Roman numerals, such as VI, VIII, VIII. Instead, the medallions will use standardized numbers, such as 6, 7, 8, respectively.
- The conference decided to include in the group reading packets "We Do Recover" (when at the end of the road....) and the 3rd Step Prayer (*Many of us have said, take my will and my life, guide me in my recovery, show me how to live*). There will be no additional charge to the group reading packets.
- The online store at www.na.org will make literature and merchandise sales from the WSO available directly from your computer. This could be helpful to those, especially those outside our fellowship, trying to purchase literature for incarcerated addicts. It will still be financially prudent for us in the Orlando Area and other Florida Areas to purchase from the FRSO, for we do not pay shipping when ordering from the FRSO.
- Donations to the WSC can also be made online.
- Each Area has been given a copy of the NAWS Strategic Plan and it is included in the RSC minutes. Any member of a home group is welcomed to get a copy from your RCM or off the website (whenever it becomes available).

- Since the WSC motion to allow areas and regions to post NA WSC-approved literature on websites failed, we are reminding our web/PI trusted servants to adhere to the Intellectual Property Trust by linking to NAWS when posting Na WSC-approved literature on orlandona.org.
- NAWS has asked all groups to utilize their area and regional NAWS representatives when updating your group information in NAWS. NAWS has been experiencing a duplication of work and effort with GSRs contacting NAWS directly when there are local trusted servants with NAWS update authority. The FLA region has approximately 5 trusted servants from the Funcoast, Heartland, Orlando (and maybe First Coast) areas with NAWS update authority. Please go through your local representatives to register your groups and update your meeting information.
- If a GSR is insistent on having their group information updated by World reps only, then please include your Area information as well as your Region information. The NAWS meeting list portion of the database now has many meetings listed under Florida Region, but not listed under an Area within the Florida Region.

- A motion to re-establish an Ad-hoc on Outreach Subcommittee is being drafted.

RSO BOD: Stuart S, Pres www.naflorida.org/trusted-servants.htm

- A new discount policy for literature sales will soon be implemented to fix the ongoing operational loss of \$550/month (+/-). The RSO will not be proposing to alter the 'free shipping' within the FLA Region.
- A Convention Services and Merchandising process has been determined and is based on a model used by NAWS for the World convention. The model is being implemented with FRCNA 23, and will slowly be rolled out to other area and regional conventions with the long-term goal of providing full service convention service (merchandise, registration, program).
- Cash flow continues to be a critical issue and is being carefully watched. Yet business goes on, so a new computer system has been delivered and has been networked to existing hardware, software licenses are being purchased when the RSO is unable to confirm whether a license has been previously purchased, and our office worker has received a cost-of-living and merit raise.

- FRCNA 23 is progressing with the acceptance of a comprehensive bid package for convention services from the FRSO. The quantities of merchandise that is being ordered is similar to the quantities that was ordered last year. This decision has been based on the number of pre-registrations that have been received. If you think that FRCNA runs out of merchandise too early, start pre-registering and tell all your friends to pre-register.
- The Board dealt with Orlando's motion to not have FRCNA fun-raisers in a host area when that host area would be holding its convention. They believe this is already dealt with in their policy. They did not admit to not adhering to their policy, however they stated that they cannot now do something that is not already contracted. They understand that Orlando does not want a FRCNA fun-raiser during the month of its area convention,
- The Board does not recommend accepting Orlando's motion regarding homegroup approval of the FRCNA program. They recommend changing policy to invite the Program, Entertainment, Registration and Merchandise Chairs to attend the FRC BOD meetings when the Host Chair is presenting their proposals. Standard travel expense will be allotted for each subcommittee chair in attendance.
- Site selection for FRCNA 26 and 27 (2007 and 2008) have resumed with bids at the Marriot Waterside in Tampa and Adam's Mark in Jacksonville. Other bids, if submitted, will be entertained.

Acting as if we were a corporation – the cost would likely run around \$800-\$900 per group per year.

The only corporate entities at our resources are the FRSO and FRC, Inc. FRC, Inc. secures a “special event” policy for the convention only. FRSO can’t feasibly secure insurance policies for an individual group or blanket coverage.

Most establishments that rent space to groups such as ours, coverage are through that establishment’s policy.

I did not contact the NAWS for any further information after speaking with others on this subject.
