## **Addendum to the COU report regarding the progress on a Dual Track Convention (Bilingual)**

After the motion to hold a dual track convention was tabled to COU for more information, we have been working diligently to supply the area with same.

The admin committee of COU met and discussed the motion. After this discussion the hotel liaison contacted the convention bureau, and received the names of the hotels large enough to handle our event. She then contacted all these facilities with the following being a synopsis of her research.

She contacted the hotels and found six that could handle us.

### Pros

1. These facilities are all large enough
2. They could all create a Spanish style banquet with "authentic Spanish Cuisine
3. They were all professional, cooperative, easy to work with and willing

### Cons

1. Cost:
  - a. Room Rates ranged from \$99 to \$159
  - b. Room Blocks they range of room blocks required were from 300 to 375 room nights. This gave us a discount (?) on the meeting space
  - c. Cost of meeting space ranged from \$300 per day for each breakout room which comes to between \$4000-6000. Another which wanted a room block of 375 was between \$7000 and \$11000. Another was a \$5000 flat rate for meeting space with a room block of 300 nights. To the best deal on the table: With a room block of 360 nights meeting space was complimentary. This may or may not included space for dances and merchandise, more will be revealed. Room rates here were only \$99
  - d. Do not know if any of these rate include parking, it is doubtful. The location of all of these would make onsite parking almost mandatory.

Conclusions: We can do it. The cost may be prohibitive and all the strides that were made to continue to lower costs and increase accessibility to our fellowship would be reversed. (Please remember 25% of those attending Unity last year paid no registration fees)

Considerations: We are not sure of the numbers, since Unidos has not been held at this time we had only Unity numbers to go by. Even after Unidos the projections would be a "guesstimate", because allot of the same people would be attending both and we would not be sure of the numbers necessary to be accommodated, nor of the number of room nights we could realistically guarantee. We will not know if the idea of a dual track convention would meet the needs of the Spanish Speaking community, and they will not be able to tell us until at least after Unidos is completed.

Recommendations: Wait until Unidos is completed. If in fact a dual track convention would be embraced by the Spanish Speaking Community; we take our best "guesstimate" regarding what would be needed and how many room nights are realistic and begin negotiations in earnest. Due to the enormity of the project and the potential financial risk and liability to the GOASCNA, we urge the area to move slowly. We, therefore, do not think it would be feasible to have this dual track convention sooner than 2008, if at all. We also believe allot of weight regarding feasibility should come from the Latino community. If they do not feel that this format would meet their needs, then we believe this whole exercise would obviously be mute. Again we stress we can not realistically expect that input from the Latino community until a reasonable time after Unidos has been completed and they can assess the success of the convention.
