Report

1. Greetings to the Greater Orlando Area ASC. Although I was unable to be here today I leave you all in very capable hands and I have sent my report with Stephanie W. For those of you who do not know I have been asked to stand as a Best Man at a very close friend's wedding. There certainly was a time in my active addiction that this would never have been considered. What a long strange trip it's been. Now to business.

I attended the FRSCNA GSR Assembly in March which, by the way was held here in Orlando. I have to admit that I was somewhat embarrassed by the showing of GSR's from Orlando. There were 7 of 23 GSR's present. To the seven who did attend I send you my accolades for participating in this process. Your contributions and honesty added a great deal of input that is very helpful to those who represent us at the WSC, our RD and AD team. To those who did not attend I ask you to take a look at whether you really know what a GSR is supposed to do. If you don't please ask. We will help you understand your responsibility. When a person shows willingness to be a Groups Representative it is incumbent upon that group to let that person know that they are the Group's voice in Narcotics Anonymous and what their job is (Third Concept) It is simply not a position that comes with a crown and a robe and recognition from others that you are somehow more important than others. You have been selected as their leader (Fourth Concept) What you get as a GSR amongst all the rewards that service can bring, is responsibility. If you are not ready for the responsibility ask for help in fulfilling that duty (Fifth Concept) The rewards of serving responsibly far outweigh the negative affects that are sure to come when we do not fulfill our responsibilities. The same old behavior yields the same old results.

2. While this section is once again devoted to our Seventh Tradition there is a difference this month. In September according to the FRSCNA Policy, the RSC is to be held in the Bahamas. Now before you go jumping to conclusions let me give you some additional information. In the eighteen years that the Florida Region has been an active Service body we have never taken an RSC to the Bahamas. You ask "why should we?" The answer is that the Bahamas Area has always been a member of the Florida Region. They have for many years continued to send ASR's, now RCM's to the FRSC and continue to be an active part of our Region. For many years they have struggled in all areas trying to carry the message to those on the Islands who still suffer from the this disease And before you say well I should be able to spend a weekend in the Bahamas on NA's dime that is not what I'm asking and certainly not the vacation you think it is. Spending all day inside a hotel after getting there on Friday night from all over the State, spending Sunday inside and then trying to make it home Sunday night is not my idea of a vacation.(Concept 11)

What I am asking is that the two Convention Committees we have in our Greater Orlando Area, who combined, have in the vicinity of \$25,000 in funds, give at least \$1500 to the FRSC in order to help several struggling area RCM's attend the RSC in September. We are very very fortunate in the Greater Orlando Area to have as strong a fellowship as we do. There are at least half of the Areas in this Region who are not as fortunate as we are, size of meetings, number of meetings, number of trusted servants, a viable working service structure, etc... Without these additional funds there will be some unrepresented Areas at our September RSC. I am appealing to our Convention Committees to take a look at whether or not we really need to have this much money to have two successful conventions. I think that we need to look at "is money property and prestige getting in the way of other Areas being able to carry our message. In the interest of **Concepts 6-9 and 11** please see it in your hearts to help others participate in our process. I also feel at this time it would be appropriate to take a look at whether we really need as much money SET ASIDE for an area convention. We are not in line with our Traditions and Concepts no matter what the good intentions were with the Five Year Plan. If we are honest about the Traditions and Concepts we would take a financial inventory of both of our Area Conventions and forward the majority of that money where it is intended to go. All I have to look at is the conflict over the past couple of years regarding the conventions and money in this Area. Please also know that this is my opinion as your Chairperson and not necessarily the opinion of NA in this Area.

3. New Business at GOASCNA-

Next month (May) will be our first attempt at Consensus based decision making in our Area. I urge you to do whatever it takes to give us your time and participation at our next ASC to make this a successful move forward to truly making decisions based on a consensus of this Area not just a simple majority vote. I believe this is a way to bring more unity to our Area and less controversy and feelings of resentment when we make decisions. Although at times we do not always fully agree it is more important to look at the fellowship as a whole than our own opinions of how things SHOULD be. **Concept Three** speaks to making decisions in haste. Consensus Based decision making disallows hasty decisions. If we truly invite a loving God (**Concept Twelve**) into our decision making process we can leave ASC with a feeling of accomplishment for the entire Area as a whole and not just individuals or groups opinions that serve only a part of our Area. As diverse as we are here in Orlando it becomes a challenge worthy of our Traditions and Concepts to come to decisions as a group with the same goal in mind, "how to better reach the addicts who still suffer. I would like to see the May ASC be a forum to

implement or at least discuss the issues that our last Spiritual Inventory brought forth as the important issues facing the Greater Orlando Area.

Last ASC was a very rewarding experience for me as a member of your Administrative Committee. Once again we were able to spend almost two hours of our ASC in a sharing Session between GSR's and other members. The open dialogue, the solution oriented discussions and the display of disagreeing without being disagreeable was a pleasure to be a part of. If you missed it I urge you to take a look at why you missed it and whether or not your group deserves your experience strength and hope. It is ASC's such as the one in March that truly make service worthwhile for me. I continue to learn not only about me but what is important for our Area and the power of unity working in this program of Narcotics Anonymous. Thank you for giving me that experience. I am eternally grateful to all those who continue to be giving, loving, honest and open minded trusted servants. You are the example to me that this program continues to work and make changes in the lives of addicts everywhere. The lie is dead....ASC is not a circus!!!!(Then came April)
