Motion #0610011 - (Learning To Live / Still Working on It)

To create an ad-hoc committee for the purpose of completing a "Spiritual Inventory" of the service structure of the Greater Orlando Area Service Committee of Narcotics Anonymous (GOASCNA). The committee is to be made up of ONE delegate representing each group of the Greater Orlando Area for purpose of each group having an equal voice in matters that may be discussed. The committee will meet once per month at a date specified and agreed to by a majority of the groups participating.

The committee membership may not include any chair or vice chair of the GOASCNA service administrative committee..

Each group participating will be allowed ONE delegate to represent their group and to participate and voice his/her group conscious.

All meetings will be open to all members of the Greater Orlando Area however for purposes of obtaining a true group conscious, only members of the committee may participate in discussions. Individual members will be allowed to discuss any items at their respective home group.

The committee, as needed and by majority vote, may invite members not on the committee to share their experience to the committee on an as needed basis.

The committee may create discussion topics for the groups as needed.

Participation of any group within the GOASCNA is strictly voluntary, however to insure a "true" group conscious, membership shall be limited to one delegate per group.

The "inventory" subcommittee shall have NO voting privileges at the ASC and is strictly an advisory committee. ALL final decisions and motions lie with the groups that make up the ASC and should be voted on at the ASC by the GSR's.

The "inventory" committee, as needed and decided by the committee's group conscious, may make reports, recommendations, and seek feedback from the groups at the ASC.

INTENT: To poll the groups of the Greater Orlando Area by developing questions and topics for discussion regarding the Area as a whole in order to create an inventory.

To create a "forum" made up of the Narcotics Anonymous groups that represent the GOASCNA to discuss various ideas, concerns, and any matters concerning the groups of the GOASCNA.

To create or enhance "unity" within the GOASCNA.

To discuss, investigate, and/or create solutions to encourage/increase participation of the GOASCNA. (Currently, our area has 20 vacant positions.)

To discuss, investigate, and/or create solutions to insure that the GOASCNA carries a "true" group conscious.

To educate, as needed and decided by the committee, less experienced groups and members through the sharing of experience, strength, and hope in service and service related issues.

To insure that the GOASCNA is fulfilling its primary purpose which is to "carry the message".

To discuss any and all issues concerning the ASC and the ASC meeting.
