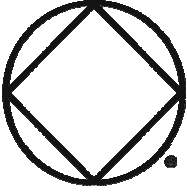
GENERAL REPORT:

GOASCNA Helpline Sub-committee Report

January 14, 2006

GENERAL REPORT:

Total Calls: 402

- High call volume this past month (as expected) due to the holidays.
- Higher number of backup calls than usual (90). While this is not in keeping with the average number of backups we receive each month it was too expected due to the holiday season.
- In further researching the possible transition from pagers to cell phones I have been able to determine the following:
 - An answering service will still be necessary in order to answer the call, give appropriate information (i.e. web address; Spanish callers etc.), and route calls to the appropriate helpline volunteer.
 - This can be purchased as an entirely automated service; however in order to prevent multiple callers from receiving a busy signal we would need to purchase multiple phone lines. This would actually increase our cost.
 - The only solution to this would be to field a call, hang up with the caller and then call them back, thereby freeing the helpline to receive another call.
 - Another challenge would be routing the calls to the proper volunteer's shift. To have automated system in place that would route a call according to a specific time frame will be no more cost effective than our current answering service.
 - To prevent this cost it would be necessary that at the end of each shift a volunteer would have to manually set their phone to forward calls to the next shift. I'm not sure that it is possible or practical to forward calls from phone to phone to phone.
 - There is no effective way (that I can think of) to have a reliable backup system in the event that a helpline volunteer misses a call.



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HELPLINE SUB-COMMITTEE

- I spoke at length with the Helpline Chair of the Tampa area to talk about the system they have in place using cell phones.
 - They use an answering service for their automated message/prompt system (she couldn't give me any information about the cost of their service).
 - Their Helpline volunteer shift is 24hrs a day for 1 week. I'm not sure this will be practical for us.
 - They have a single physical line which means that the entire time the volunteer is speaking with an addict the helpline phone number is busy.
 - They have no backup system in place for any missed calls.

- It would seem to me that to effectively answer every single call that comes to the Helpline and to better serve the addict who is still suffering, it is in this areas best interest to keep the current pager system we now have in place.
