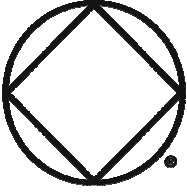

SPECIFIC CONCERNS OR NEEDS:

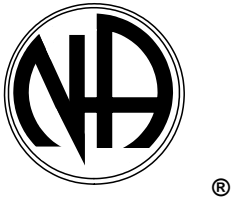
Helpline is always in need of willing pager carriers to help carry the message.
