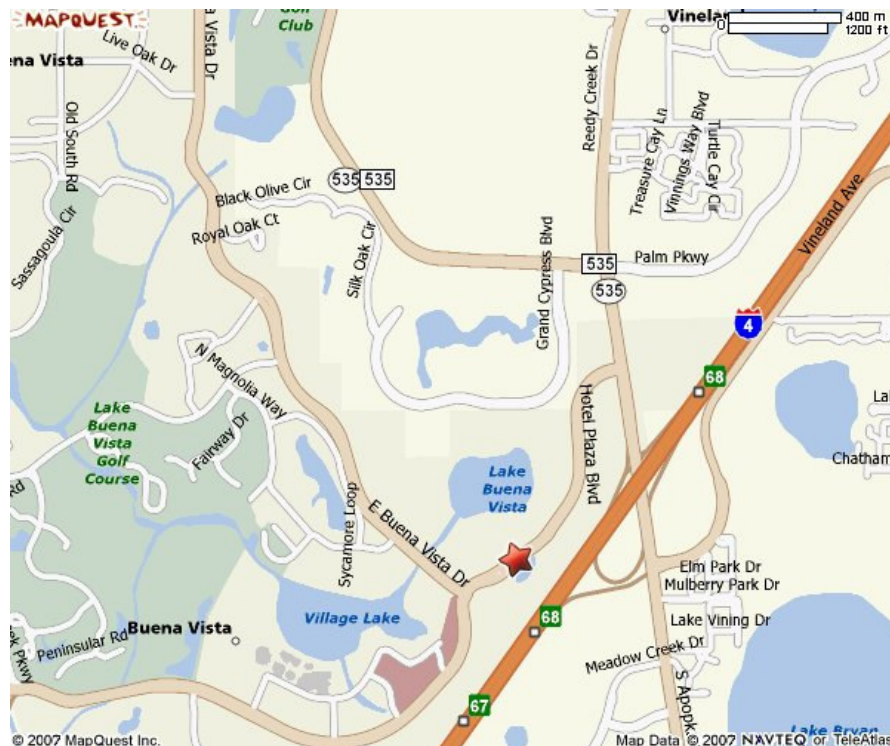

FRSC Treasurer's Report : Ending Register Balance after Prudent Reserve as of 08/31/07 is \$21,128.30.

FRSC : Area Reports

Bahamas Area : Had no representation at RSC, but PI announced on behalf of Bahamas that they now have a new meeting which is held at a different location. So the Bahamas now has 3 groups. Convention will be November 1-4, 2007 at the Wyndam Crystal Palace Cable Beach .

Bay Area : The area has 51 home groups and 97 weekly meetings. H & I carries the message to 9 facilities with 100 meetings. Eight home groups have lost their facilities due to inappropriate behavior. Seven home groups have found a new facility. One is still searching for a place to meet. We are in the process of discussing ways of addressing this problem. Big Bend Area : Has 13 groups with 30 meeting per week. H & I carrying 8 meetings into 6 facilities a week.

Chain O' Lakes Area : 10 groups and 17 meetings per week. 1 meeting carried into a Detox Unit and another into the Lake Correctional Institute.

Daytona Area : Currently has 25 groups and 42 meetings. DACNA 9 will be happening in April 2008

First Coast Area : Has 30 home groups and there is a meeting every day of the week.

Forest Area : 5 groups currently holding 27 meetings per week. H & I has 3 meetings per week in 3 facilities. – www.forestareana.org.

Heartland Area : The number of weekly meetings has increased over the past year, from 50 to 65. We currently have 9 H & I facilities being served with requests from 3 additional facilities. Currently the committee is working on being able to serve the 3 additional facilities. We provide 32 presentations per month, and reach about 875 addicts. The Heartland Area's 5th annual convention will be held at the River Ranch Resort, October 19-21 2007. This is a great resort with plenty to do such as: miniature golf, shooting, rodeo, fishing, and boat rentals. Last year, the convention lost money. Palm Coast Area : 49 groups with 74 meeting weekly. 26th Serenity in the Sun Convention, to be held on Thanksgiving weekend.

Recovery Coast : 13 groups with 15 meetings weekly.

River Coast Area : 12 groups and 20 meetings. Area is growing. H & I has 3 presentations. on October 27th they will be having a Halloween Dinner Dance @ Floral City Community Center 5:30-6:30 p.m. Kid's party, 6:30-7:30 p.m. pot-luck dinner, 7:45-8:45 p.m. speaker meeting and a dance to follow 9p.m. to 12:00 a.m.

Space Coast Area : The Space Coast area has 9 groups and 36 meetings a week. H & I currently hold 5 meetings a week in two different facilities. The group Principles before Personalities will be having a Halloween Dance October 26, 2007.

Suncoast Area : 37 groups with 51 meetings per week. H & I with 10 meetings into 8 facilities.

Tampa Fun Coast Area : 58 groups with 97 meetings a week. The Hospitals and Institutions Committee has exceeded their goal of 100 books for the institutions. They will be passing out the books to jails and institutions. Before they do that, each book will have the name of the H&I committee as well as the helpline number – 813-879-HELP. The committee also has 9 active facilities/institutions.

Treasure Coast Area : 25 groups holding 43 weekly meetings. Hospitals and Institutions subcommittee members help to take 10 meetings into 8 different institutions.

Uncoast Area : We currently have 34 meetings a week in Gainesville and the surrounding towns, and 19 home groups represented at ASC. We have 4 H & I meetings per week.

Regional Subcommittee Reports :

Fellowship Development : Planning a Learning Day in one of the struggling areas, likely the Chain O' Lakes Area.

Help Line : Planning a motion to host a 12 step call workshop at FRCNA 27.

H & I : There were 12 out of 17 Areas represented, and together we held 467 presentations in 76 facilities with 34 contact facilities.

Public Relations : Support to various areas issues were addressed. NAWS will be attending an event in Clearwater, Florida in January 14th through 17th and more will be revealed.

Internet Technologies : We are in the midst of our comprehensive 4 stage project. Need Policy or job description for Internet Technology Coordinator. For the Website they are in the process of migrating services to a CMS (Content Management System). This is Phase 1 and should be complete by October. They are also working on the pushing out the calendar system to areas for a unified calendar services. The goal of this system is to have an area put an event in their calendar and have it immediately propagate to the Regional calendar and all other area calendars.

We are further requesting to have your GSRs read this letter to their home groups. Hopefully this letters with answer some questions that have been raised about the Support committees. 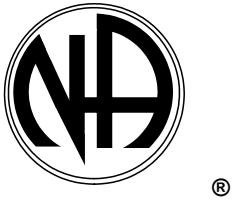
