- We discussed more about switching to cell phones for the helpline. My research has indicated that all of the major cell phone companies are pretty close in price. I checked with Sprint, AT&T & Verizon. The prices were \$149.00 for 2 lines and 9.99 for each additional line (max. of 5 lines). The best provider seems like it would be AT&T due to the "Rollover" minute benefits, which would let us keep any unused minutes at the end of the month.

The next option would be the use of Metro PCS phones with unlimited talk time for \$40-45/month (unlimited number of phone lines). There are a few deadspots around the central florida area, but according to Metro PCS, these will be covered in the next year.

- The OneBox routing feature would be approx. \$75/month. This would bring the helpline expenses for these items to approx. \$345/month. We are spending that amount right now on the Metropolitan answering service alone. Plus an additional \$220 on at&t and shamrock paging every month. It will be a big job to get this system up and running, but I believe this will be the cheaper and more effective way to field calls.

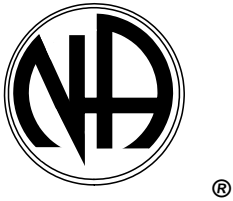
