Dear GO ASC,

Our search for a permanent ASC facility continued since our last ASC. During February's Admin meeting, 3 of the 6 Admin attendees felt it was best to continue meeting at Oviedo Memorial, in order to maintain continuity of day and time and allow all of the elected trusted servants to fulfill their positions, even though the Oviedo facility was the most expensive to rent.

Your Chair took this information under advisement and attempted to reserve the Oviedo Memorial in April, and thru July since Oviedo only allows monthly contracts. I also intended to continue to look for a less expensive facility, for more prudent use of NA funds. Oviedo was booked in April, thus not available to us. This tells me that God is ensuring we heed to "Prudent Use of NA Funds" and that renting a facility on a month-to-month basis cannot provide continuity nor security.

The only other Sunday morning alternative, which allowed us to begin set-up at 10 am., was pulled from us by the Church's Pastor, the day after the facility was looked at by trusted servants. The Pastor will not allow any outside groups to meet at his Church on Sundays.

To maintain consistency of schedule, GOASCNA now has two (2) Sunday alternatives:

- 1) beginning ASC at Noon or later in the afternoon
- 2) alternating ASC on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of the month or the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of the month, depending upon when facilities are available and when there is no interference with other NA events or holidays, i.e. July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend is FRCNA and it is being held during the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of July, possibility New Years Day

Unfortunately, in either alternative, trusted servants may resign from their positions, for they had made commitments from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of the month.

Per the GOASCNA Guidelines, your Chair has been delegated the responsibility to secure the ASC facility. In the best interest of the Greater Orlando Area and NA as a whole, I have secured the Englewood Neighborhood Center for it allows us to continue to meet every 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday. No NA recovery meetings are being held from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m., and those groups who hold their business meetings during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of the month will not have change their business meeting schedules.

To the Greater Orlando Area,

The Recovery Matters Group of Narcotics Anonymous would like to pose some questions regarding the Unidos Convention:

1. The Line Items in the proposed budget do not equal the total. There is upwards of \$9,000 unaccounted for in the Line items as compared to the budget. When will a complete proposed budget be submitted for approval?
2. There are many fundraisers scheduled. If there is a bank account totaling \$9,000 why are fundraisers needed at all. Shouldn't these really be "fun" raisers and free to all members?
3. Why is there a \$9,000 bank account? What is all of this money being set aside for? Most Area Conventions throughout the World do not exceed \$4,000 for seed money for conventions much larger than this Area convention. This doesn't seem to be in accordance with our fund flow nor does it agree with our 6<sup>th</sup> Tradition.
4. With the GOASCNA struggling with funds at the present time why is all this money being set aside if the Unidos convention committee is a subcommittee of the greater orlando area? This does not seem to be a prudent use of NA funds.
5. Lastly, we heard this convention announced as a bilingual convention. When this idea was posed several years ago it was stated that this was to be a Spanish speaking convention. When did this change and is Unidos now willing to join forces with Unity and have one bi-lingual Area Convention?

While we in NA have proven that we can raise the required funds necessary for any given need we must bare in mind that the trusted servants of Area and any Subcommittee of the Area are the stewards of the donations members make to both our seventh tradition baskets in meetings and those funds raised at activities. That money is designated to be used for the needs of the greater whole and must be used responsibly in all areas of our service structure. Something seems amiss when one subcommittee has a four digit bank account and the Area itself is operating on a shoestring at best. Recovery Matters would like to see the GOASNA take a good long hard look at our traditions, concepts, principles, fund flow, the needs of NA as a whole and ask ourselves if we have gone horribly off track and are getting ourselves into a situation that our sixth tradition speaks about, i.e Money Property and prestige diverting us from our primary purpose.
