Dear GO ASC,

The Administrative Committee met two weeks ago, to discuss the Administrative and Subcommittee budgets for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010. Today, our Treasurer/Alternate Treasurer will present an overview on budgets, followed by a presentation of the FY '09-10 Administrative budget by our Vice Chair.

Your Chair has heard from some members of our Area who believe that it is not necessary to give the Englewood Community Center a donation. Their belief is that the City of Orlando's not-for-profit offer to us is the same that they offer to other not-for-profit organizations. We are paying the \$100 security deposit and the monthly insurance fee of \$31.83, just like every other not-for-profit. Hence we are not taking advantage of our community by not paying the required fees. I see the validity in their reasoning. Even so, to ensure that we are adhering to our 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition and are being fully self-supporting, your Chair is going to follow through with a monthly donation to the Englewood Community Center.

The proposed donation will be \$10/hr, or a maximum of \$50 per meeting. This hourly amount is the same price that we had been paying the City of Oviedo when we went over our 3-hour monthly commitment. Your Chair is also going to proceed with our offer to supply an IP literature rack filled with IPs, in both English and Spanish, for the Englewood Community Center. This IP rack will be an 'in-kind' donation to the facility, and in addition to the hourly fee.

Last month, our Area passed Motion 0902011P. This new policy, to no longer keep a 2-month literature inventory, necessitates a look at the GOASCNA Guidelines, section I. General Committee Guidelines, i. Literature/Literature Distribution, c. the starter kit. Does this Area want to keep an English and Spanish starter kit on hand for the times when a new meeting begins and a representative comes to ASC to request a starter kit? Or does this Area want the new meeting to wait one (1) month in-between requesting a starter kit and receiving it? If the former question (the 1<sup>st</sup> question) is favored, then we need to update our Guidelines, via a policy motion, stating that we need to keep, one each of, English and Spanish starter kits on-hand.
