Dear GO ASC,

Last month, our Area passed Motion 0902009P with a majority vote of 10/5/4. This motion was called 'approved' by your Chair with majority approval of 1 more than $\frac{1}{2}$ voting 'yeh', not policy approval of $\frac{2}{3}$ voting 'yeh'. After ASC, your Chair felt the need to research prior budget and money motions, our guidelines and minutes, and seek input from various GSRs.

My findings and recommendation are that budget motions are not policy motions, for they do not effect the GOASCNA guidelines and how we conduct business at our ASC's. Budget motions are like all other monetary motions and require a majority approval. Also, budget motions do not require a 'P' in their numeration or policy notation in the minutes. If you GSRs disagree with this reasoning, please submit a motion at today's ASC for budget motions will be presented in New Business.

In 2007, the ASC Chair recommended to include all approved committee budgets in the policy packets, at the end of the GOASCNA guidelines. His reasoning was so that all trusted servants would have easy access to the approved budgets. At that time, the GSRs agreed with this process. The 2007 and 2008 budgets were presented and passed a policy motions.

Prior to 2007, budget motions were not considered policy motions. Nor were they kept in the policy packet, for easy to access.

My question to the GSRs and groups is, do you want our Area to consider budget motions as all other money motions or as policy motions? We will need a decision, via one-time motion, at today's ASC for all other committee budgets are being presented in today's New Business.

Also, when discussing the inclusion of convention committee budgets in the new budget template with the Unidos Subcommittee, the question of prudent reserve came up. GOASCNA's practice is to not include money producing subcommittees or Activity events in the prudent reserve calculation, however our guidelines do not clearly state this. Please refer to IV. ASC Finances, "D. The prudent reserve will consist of: 2. One month subcommittee expenses." Will someone (Treasurer or GSR) please present a policy motion to clarify our prudent reserve calculation. Thank you.

To Admin,

I would like to begin by thanking the Chair for all the time and effort that has been spent securing a meeting room for ASC. I personally am very pleased with the location, size of the room and the price, although, I have specific concerns about the \$50 rental payment. I am requesting your opinions and insight regarding the Admin budget and this expense.

I am going to make an attempt to explain my point of view, thoughts that I have had and **my side** of conversations that I have been involved with. Knowing that there is two sides to every story if I am incorrect in anything that I write please know it is not intentional. And I welcome any input.

As the chair has explained in her reports we were granted not-for profit status for the Englewood Center by the City of Orlando. The only fee required is \$31.83 for insurance and a \$100 security deposit. This information was brought to the ASC. At that time a GSR presented the argument that we should pay an additional amount for rent to keep in accordance with the 7th tradition. During an Admin meeting, the topic was discussed. There were four people present and it was decided by majority vote that we would pay an additional \$50.

Prior to the Admin meeting the Chair and I had gone to the Englewood Center. At that time we discussed with an employee of Englewood that we would like to pay some rent in addition to the insurance. We were told that the City of Orlando was not set up to receive rent for not for profit organizations but the Englewood Center could accept a gift card. They requested a card from Publix so they could buy additional supplies for their programs.

My problem is: I believe the \$50 is a donation not rent. The Sixth Tradition states, "The next thing we ought never do is finance. This is more obvious. To finance means to supply funds or to help support financially." The 7th tradition was used to support the additional payment. But as I read the 7th tradition it also states "We take a collection in our meetings to cover these expenses and whatever is left goes to support our services and to further our primary purpose." Since I view the \$50 as a donation opposed to

rent, I also believe this payment would be a violation of the 6th and 7th tradition.

I find no fault in the actions of the chair. Our policy clearly states that it is the Chairperson's responsibility "to secure facility to hold monthly ASC". Also, the Fifth Concept reads, "When we decide a certain service task should be done, and clearly say which trusted servant, service board, or committee has the authority to accomplish the task, we avoid unnecessary confusion." "Project reports come straight from the single point of decision for the project, offering the best information available". The Chair has done an excellent job fulfilling the task assigned.

I have brought my concerns to the chair and we are not in agreement. I believe the groups should decide the payment. Since the chair did report all of this in her report and no one opposed she felt the groups decided it. I am requesting that you review my findings and advise. I intend to receive all input and to re-evaluate my position. I hope we can resolve this issue and bring a collective decision to the floor or not. If not and I decide that I have a valid point I intend to bring this situation to "open floor".

I am thanking you in advance for your time and for any information that might help.
