Motion# 0808010-To form and adhoc to investigate the process and in and outs of a donate button on GOASCNA Website like the one World has on that website:

This was turned over to webpage subcommittee to investigate and recommend solution. This is not the new motion.

1. After looking at the choices for a donate button, PayPal appears to be the clear choice as the way to add a donate button to accept contributions on the www.orlandona.org website:
 - A. Merchant bank accounts are very expensive to set up and difficult to manage
 - B. PayPal has no startup cost and low transaction fee (2.9% + \$.30). Lower if we can qualify as nonprofit organization. Example:
 $\$ 10.00 - \$.29 - \$.30 = \$ 9.41$ donation. With this low transaction fee the WPSC does not feel a minimum donation to achieve break even is necessary.
 - C. PayPal is easy to implement on website with different options for how transactions are processed
 - D. You do not have to be a member of PayPal to make donations
2. WPSC recommends Area consider impact in the following areas:
 - A. Someone in Area will be required to administer PayPal account.
 1. Will require internet access
 2. Will require knowledge of Goascna bank's routing and account numbers
 3. Will require additional work from Treasurer and/or Vice-Treasurer
 4. Management would be very simple and should not be time consuming
 5. Setup should also be simple and not time consuming
 6. Whoever administers account will have to start the account
 - B. Impact on Area
 1. No negatives
 2. Positives are extra revenue source for Area
 - C. Impact on 7th tradition
 1. There is no short term way to tabulate data on whether Donate button would impact collections at group meetings. The WPSC feels this would most likely be insignificant.
 2. There must be a disclaimer about non NA members not being allowed to donate on the website to preserve the 7th tradition.

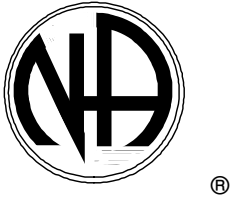

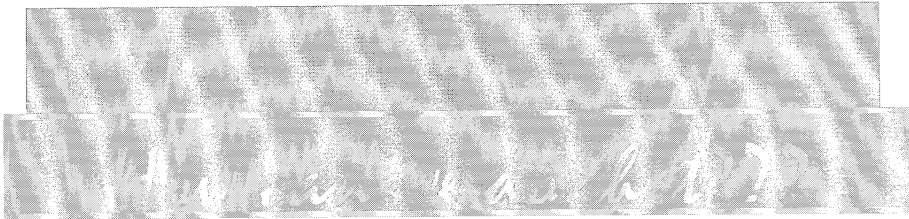
