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Ad-Hoc on Hearing Impaired

GOASCNA Ad-hoc Report

Jan. 10, 2010

GENERAL REPORT:

This second Ad-Hoc on Hearing Impaired was formed at the November 2009 ASC when Motion #091004, "To start the training process of the recommendation of the Ad-Hoc on Hearing Impaired," carried.

Total membership: 8 (7 present at 1/8 meeting, 1 excused)

- 4 members at 12/18/09 meeting

- 4 more members at 1/8 meeting

Clean time ranges from 9 months to 19 years.

- Average clean time age = 4 years

- Median clean time age = 3 years

ASL skill level varies:

- 2 members have completed intermediate classes or higher

- 1 member has completed a beginner class

- 1 member is planning to take ASL training, with or without NA assistance

- 3 members are willing to learn

Group representation from all 3 Greater Orlando Area counties:

- Changing Thru the Steps

- Eastside Recovery

- H.O.W. To Live

- Just For Today

- Miracle at Noon

- Solo Por Hoy

- Young & Free

Various local training programs have been researched. They include local universities, a Hearing Impaired/ASL company, and self-help organizations. We have found that the universities (UCF, Valencia and SEC) require additional fees, such as application, in addition to the class registration, taxes and books.

A hearing impaired/ASL company, American Sign Language Services, Inc., (www.aslservices.com) is less expensive. The registration cost for one student will be \$880 + taxes + books for approximately 2 years of training.

Most self-help, civic or social organizations have had to stop their ASL training programs due to the current economic situation. There are 3 local Baptist Churches providing free classes, open to the public. The Ad-hoc is hesitant to utilize these classes

because the focus of the Baptist Hearing Impaired Ministry is to “effectively minister God’s word....share the Gospel of Jesus Christ”. The Center for Independent Living will only engage an ASL teacher for a hearing impaired person. However, they referred us to Lisa McClung.

Ms McClung has her own primary purpose, or ministry, to help the hearing impaired. She is willing to interpret at one meeting per week and teach our members ASL for a donation, a donation that GOASCNA sees fit. Our committee believes it is in the best interest of NA for one of our members with intermediate ASL training to interview Ms. McClung before bringing the ad-hoc’s recommendation to the Area. If this interview goes well and the Ad-hoc recommends engaging her services, Ms McClung is willing to teach a class to NA members and interpret at one meeting per week. The NA students will be required to purchase a sign language book and attend as many meetings possible where Ms. McClung is interpreting. The purpose of student attendance is to practice sign language in between classes, for it’s human nature to loose what is not used. These meetings will be pre-determined by those groups willing to work with the Ad-hoc. The Ad-hoc will request that the pre-determined meetings be listed as “ASL” in the GOASCNA meeting lists. The Ad-hoc sees this idea as a win-win solution for we will have an experienced interpreter at our meetings and recovering addicts will be learning how to welcome any hearing impaired addict into our meetings and carry the message of recovery in sign language. This training will not prepare our NA students with ASL interpreter certification or professional status. We will have a decision by the February ASC.

SPECIFIC CONCERNS OR NEEDS:

We have found that ASL training will take a minimum of 2 years before a student is qualified as an ASL interpreter. Our first Ad-hoc on Hearing Impaired determined that there are various meetings in the Greater Orlando Area that were being attended by the Hearing Impaired in 2007-2009. The Greater Orlando Area has had three (3) contacts with professionals in the past 2 years, requesting meeting information with ASL interpretation. These professionals are:

2008 ASC and GOASCNA Web Page: Mr. Hector LaValle, Center for Drug Free Living

2009 phone call to ASC Chair: Ms. Phyllis Oliva, 407-765-4801

2009 phone call to GOASCNA Help Line: Mr. Vic Meely, ACT Center, 800-316-7610

Based on the above communications, we believe that the Greater Orlando Area cannot wait 2 or more years before recovering addicts are properly trained. We see the immediate need for weekly meetings in the Greater Orlando Area that provides ASL interpretation for the hearing impaired addicts in our Area. If our Area is to fulfill its primary purpose, we need to engage the services of a qualified ASL now. (see 1/8/10 meeting minutes, Motion #1).

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. To the ASC GSRs: at your February business meetings or before then, ask your group members for permission to have an ASL interpreter attend once a week. Please inform the Chair of this Ad-hoc Committee if your group is willing.

(See "GSR Reminder" appended to this report)

Requirements:

1. Open meeting required
 2. Speaker meeting (ideal room set-up)
 3. Hearing impaired reserved seating in front of the addict speaking and ASL interpreter
2. The Area increase the Admin Budget, ASL line item from \$200 to \$2000, for FY 2009/10. This fee will cover the expenses to engage one of the interpreting service researched during the first Ad-hoc on Hearing Impaired. These companies cost \$110-130 per meeting. (GOASCNA motion # 0110###)
- NOTE:** The current Ad-hoc does not want to unnecessarily spend NA funds, hence we are looking at Ms. Lisa McClung as a much less expensive alternative to the professional ASL companies in the Greater Orlando Area. The Ad-hoc is willing to take other suggestions to investigate and compare to the services already researched or in progress, in order to provide the most economical solution.
3. The GOASCNA guidelines, IV. ASC Finances, I. The Priority List... be amended to include a line item for "ASL Interpreter" after #4. Meeting Lists and before #5. ASC Minutes, making the line item "ASL Interpreter" the new #5.
 4. To the RCMs: to request information at the January RSC from the other Areas of the Florida Region on how they are addressing, or have addressed, carrying the message of recovery to the hearing impaired addict in their groups and meetings.

2. Will they have a definitive commitment?

3. What will be the clean time requirement?
