- We wish it was not necessary, but costs of production have risen so dramatically that we believe scheduling a price increase is prudent. Effective 1 January 2023, the price of all books and bronze medallions will increase 12%. We are not recommending increases on the materials our NA groups most frequently give away, even though our costs have increased substantially on these items as well. That means there will be no increase to the current prices of IPs, booklets, key tags, or chips. This feels the most helpful way to show that we are all in this together and to do what we can to ease the burden on groups. We attended the Project Opioid candle light visual We attended Project Noelle with is an event every year for family members who have lost loved one to overdose. We made contact with OPD and will be following up to re-introduce there new Drug overdose investigators. We have made contact with Dr. Hall with Orange county Drug Free Community about being included in a PSA and gas station gas pumps.

From the yap system we had 49 calls in the month of September

- Most of the phone calls were answered
- All the voicemails were answered (calls returned) when the caller left a name and phone number.
- We have a new volunteer, Dale D, he received orientation by Jessica M in Mid-September and his number was added to the Yap system to be able to answer phone calls.
