On March 1, 2023, the opening bank balance was \$ 56,341.40. After deposits of \$15,019.44 and expenses of \$24,349.99 on April 30, 2023, the ending book balance was \$47,010.85. After deducting \$10,000.00 withheld for the next RSC, the Prudent Reserve of \$11,000.00, a Women in Service Donation of \$75.00, the GSR Assembly Reserve of \$500.00, and the Florida Service Symposium Reserve of \$26,000.00 the available balance was (\$564.15).
