## Treasure Report

On March 1, 2023, the opening bank balance was \$56,341.40. After deposits of \$15,019.44 and expenses of \$24,349.99 on April 30, 2023, the ending book balance was \$47,010.85. After deducting \$10,000.00 withheld for the next RSC, the Prudent Reserve of \$11,000.00, a Women in Service Donation of \$75.00, the GSR Assembly Reserve of \$500.00, and the Florida Service Symposium Reserve of \$26,000.00 the available balance was (\$564.15).

As of RSC held on May 21, 2023, we received \$1,153.42 in income and had \$7,076.93 in expenses.

Additionally, we allocated the monthly reserve of \$500.00 for the GSR Assembly & \$1,000.00 the Florida Service Symposium. Therefore, after RSC business the available balance was (\$7,987.66).
